

# TransLink Goes Beyond Transit

At TransLink, we provide more than public transit to the region. We help make Metro Vancouver a great place to live by partnering with local governments on streets, sidewalks and cycling-infrastructure projects.

**In 2019, we contributed nearly \$100 million to maintenance and upgrade projects.**

These investments strengthen the region's economy and build stronger, more vibrant communities by making it easier for people to get around safely and efficiently, whatever their mode of travel.

## Maintaining the Major Road Network (MRN)

**675 km**

(2,738 lane kilometres) of Major Road Network is the responsibility of TransLink.

Invested **\$148 m**

to operate, maintain and rehabilitate the Major Road Networks

Invested **\$55.9 m**

in 2019

to help keep the Major Road Network in a state of good repair.

Maintained over **8000** structures

since 2017

helping keep drivers safe on structures such as bridges, culverts, and retaining walls

Maintained over **1700** traffic signals
