Capilano buses will carry front signs reading: CAPI-LANO-RIDGE (Ridgewood), CAPILANO-MONT (Montroyal).

Highland and Larson buses are so marked.

Keith buses will carry one

of three front-signs and, when routed that way, will also carry a cardboard sign in the winds' id stating: VIA SEYMOUR. The three signs: KEITH-SEYMOUR, KEITH - HASTINGS and (outbound from Vancouver) N VAN-FERRY.

Finally, instead of marking buses "GARAGE", they will carry the sign: 3rd-ST DAVIDS.

Changes and Improvements

Major changes and improvements to transit service in Vancouver, Burnaby and North Vancouver will be made next Friday, October 23rd.

These are the culmination of months of study and planning by our people in the Transit Division. Each change has been, as you've been reading periodically in the papers, thoroughly discussed with the Councils concerned, and their approval obtained.

In addition, the Public Utilities Commission and the Board of Transport Commissioners have been applied to, and after full consideration, have also approved.

So now at last we're ready to go ahead and implement this latest step in the Transit Improvement Program. The present issue of *The Buzzer* is given over to summarizing the whole thing. We hope you'll keep this copy with you until you're familiar with the new arrangements.

Don't forget, also, that our Transit Information Bureau (KErrisdale 7500) is always ready, day or night,



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to answer any questions you may have about these changes, or, indeed, about any transit problem that comes to mind.

Last but by no means least, your B. C. Electric operator will be glad to help you at any time.

* * *

As with large-scale changes in the past, we should again like to ask the special co-operation of passengers — individually and collectively — during the first few days after the changeover takes effect next Friday.

Undoubtedly there will be rough spots in the service during this break-in period. Any new endeavor takes time to "shake down". Routes and schedules are new to your driver, too.

* * *

So we hope you'll be as tolerant as possible of any shortcomings in the first few days of the new operations. We'll be working hard to iron 'em out and to provide a high standard of service as quickly, and consistently, as we can.

Many thanks, ladies and gentlemen! And now for the details of the Friday changes:

VANCOUVER

Knight bus service will be extended southward to Marine Drive, and will travel downtown via two routes. This will replace the existing Knight Road and Terminal-1st Ave. servi 3. (See (A) on Vancouver Map, page 4.)

Route: Marine and Knight via Knight and Clark to Terminal Avenue, with half the service routed via Terminal, Main and Pender and the other half via Clark, Venables, Campbell, Prior, Jackson and Pender to a common loop at Victory Square via Pender, Homer, Hastings and Cambie,

Schedule: Weekdays: 12 minutes, 6 minutes in rush; Wednesdays: 15 minutes, 7½ in rush; Saturdays: 9 minutes, 7½ in rush; Sundays: 15 to 20 minutes all day; evenings: 15 minutes.

Nanaimo bus service will be extended both southward, and into the downtown area. (See (B) on Vancouver Map, page 4.)

Route: From terminal at Copley via Nanaimo, Powell, Columbia and Cordova to loop via Homer, Dunsmuir, Richards and Cordova and return over the same route. This service replaces the existing Nanaimo shuttle and the 12th Ave.-Nanaimo services.

Schedule: Weekdays: 15 minutes, 6 in rush; Wednesdays: 20 minutes, 8 in rush; Saturdays: 15 minutes, 12 in rush; Sundays: 20 minutes



BURNABY

Here is a summary of the new all-bus system in Burnaby as it will operate on and after Friday. Please note that new routes are being introduced, others are being discontinued, while still others are being changed in one or more places. New schedules will apply on all lines.

Burnaby-Edmonds will be a new express service. After it leaves Burnaby, it will stop to let off passengers only where Vancouver City lines intersect, namely:

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Kingsway at Boundary; Joyce, Rupert, Victoria, Knight, Fraser, Broadway, Main at Terminal, Pender, and Columbía. (See (A), Burnaby Map, page 10.)

In the reverse direction it will pick up passengers bound for New Westminster and Burnaby at the above stops only.

In short, it is designed specifically for Burnaby and Royal City patrons and not for Vancouver passengers.

It will provide local service in Burnaby.

Route: From Larwill Bus Depot at Dunsmuir and Cambie via Cambie, Pender, Main, and Kingsway to Edmonds, where it will connect with New Westminster transit lines.

Fares: Regular Burnaby fares will apply in Burnaby. Passengers travelling between Vancouver, Burnaby and New Westminster will pay a combination of the Vancouver City fares and Burnaby-New Westminster Zone fares.

Schedule: 20 minute service operated . conjunction with Burnaby-Stride buses. Extra service in rush hours.



Schedule: 20 minute service operated in conjunction with the Vancouver -Edmonds service so as to provide 10-minute frequency between Larwill Depot and Kingsway and Nelson. Extra service in rush hours.

Evenings and Sundays and holidays, 20 minute frequency on this line between Nelson and Stride on Kingsway, connecting at Nelson and Kingsway with Vancouver-Edmonds bus, and at Stride and Kingsway with New Westminster transit routes.

Weekdays and Saturdays

-5.49 a.m., 6.09, .29, .49, then 7.00, .20, .40, then 8.03, .23. .43. etc., and every 20 minutes thereafter until 12.23 midnight: last bus at 1.13 a.m.

Note: Rush-hour buses leave Nelson and Rumble for Larwill Depot on the hour and every 10 minutes thereafter.

Sundays - 6.03 a.m., then 7.03 and half hourly until 9.43 a.m., then every 20 minutes at .03, .23, .43, etc., past hour; last bus at 1.13 a.m.

Note: Early and late buses go to Nelson and Kingsway only, connecting there with Edmonds - Kingsway buses. Mid-day buses go to Broadway and Kingsway only.

Lv. Larwill Depot

Weekdays and Saturdays -6 a.m., then .10, .30, .50, etc., until 8.50 p.m. After 8.50 passengers for Stride bus take Edmonds bus. transferring at Nelson and Kingsway.

Rush - On the hour and every 20 minutes thereafter -to Stride and Nelson only.

Sundays - Passengers for Stride and Rumble take Edmonds - Kingsway bus at 6.55 a.m. and every 30 minutes thereafter until 10.55 a.m., then 11.20, .40, etc., making connections with Stride bus at Kingsway and Nelson.

Note: This is shuttle service between Stride and

Kingsway and Nelson and Kingsway during evenings (after 8 p.m.) and on Sundays and holidays.

McKay - Kingsway buses will travel from McKay and Kingsway via McKay, Imperial, Sussex, Rumble, Patterson, Marine Drive, Joffre, Rumble, Sussex, and return over the same route. (See (C), Burnaby Map, page 10.)

Schedule: 30 minute service, with greater frequency in rush hours.

Lv. McKay and Kingsway Weekdays rush—5.56 a.m., then 6.09, and every 15 minutes thereafter. Non-rush: Half-hourly at .24 and .54 past hour; last trip 12.24 a.m.

- Saturdays—Quarter-hourly all day at .09, .24, .39 past hour until 6.54 p.m., then half-hourly.

Sundays—7.24 a.m. and half-hourly thereafter.

Lv. Marine and Joffre

Weekdays rush—6.08 and every 15 minutes thereafter. Non-rush — Half-hourly at .08 and .38 past hour; last trip 12.38 a.m.

Saturdays—Quarter-hourly at .08, .23, .38 past hour until 7.08 p.m., then half-hourly.

Sundays — 7.24 a.m., and half-hourly thereafter.

Gilmore-Willingdon buses will operate over two routings, and trips will alternate on each one. (See (D), Burnaby Map, page 10.) The first route will be from Hastings and Kootenay via Hastings, Gilmore, Douglas, Lough ed, Douglas, Grandview Highway, Burris and Sperling to Kingsway, looping via Kingsway and Arcola.

The other route will be from Hastings and Kootenay via Hastings, Willingdon, Lougheed, Douglas, Grandview Highway, Burris and Walker to Kingsway at Edmonds.

Every second southbound trip on the common portion of the route will be diverted via Sprott and Norland.

Schedule: 60 minutes on each individual route, which will provide 30-minute frequency on the common portion of this line. More frequent service will be provided during rush hours on the section between Hastings and Kootenay and Douglas Road at Springer.

Gilmore-Willingdon Lv. Edmonds via Walker

Weekdays and Saturdays -5.30 a.m. and hourly thereafter to 12.30 midnight. Sundays - 7.30 a.m. and hourly thereafter to 11.30 p.m.

Lv. Sperling and Kingsway Weekdays and Saturdays
6 a.m., and hourly thereafter to midnight.

Sundays—7 a.m. and hourly thereafter until midnight. Lv. Kootenay via Gilmore

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p.m. and .30 past hour thereafter. Lv. Bainbridge and Lougheed for Kootenay Loop at .35 past hour until 12.39 p.m., then 1.49 p.m. and .49 past hour thereafter.

Vancouver Heights, Capitol Hill, and Hastings-Duthie routes remain unchanged, but some schedules are altered to improve or even-out service. (You can obtain a new timetable for all or any of the routes mentioned here at B. C. Electric depots, or from your operator).

Vancouver Heights Schedule — Weekdays and Saturdays: Lv. Kootenay Loop—.05 and .35 past hour; Lv. Albert and Willingdon— .20 and .50 past hour. Sundays: Lv. Kooteney Loop— 7.35 a.m., 8.30 and on half hour thereafter. Lv. Albert and Willingdon—7.45 a.m., and .45 past hour thereafter.

Capitol Hill Weekdays and Saturdays: Lv. Kootenay Loop—.18 and .48 past hour in rush, and .20 past hour in non-rush. Lv. Howard and Cambridge —.03 and .33 past hour in rush, and .35 past hour in non-rush. Sundays: Lv. Kootenay Loop—on hour; Lv. Howard and Cambridge —.17 past hour until 1.17 p.m., then 2.15 and .15 past hour thereafter.

Hastings - Duthie

Weekdays and Saturdays: Lv: Kootenay Loop for Duthie and Halifax—.10 and .40 past hour in rush; and .10 past hour in non-rush. Lv. Kootenay Loop for Westridge—.10 and .40 past hour all day. Lv. Duthie and Halifax for Kootenay Loop —.08 and .38 past hour in rush; .38 past hour in nonrush. Lv. Westridge for Kootenay Loop—.12 and .42 past hour all day.

Sundays: Lv. Kootenay for Duthie and Halifax—on hour till noon, then 1.10 p.m. and .10 past hour thereafter. Lv. Duthie and Halifax for Kootenay—.20 past hour till 12.20 p.m., then 1.30 p.m. and .30 past hour thereafter.

New Bus Signs

A number of new bus signs will be used, and most of them speak the destinations of the vehicles clearly.

However, a word of explanation may help on some others. In the following, Bus Signs are in CAPITALS.

Eastbound from Vancouver: To Edmonds—BURN-A B Y - E D M O N D S; to Stride — B U R N A B Y -STRIDE; to Clinton and Gilley—BURNABY-CLIN-TON; to Nelson and Kingsway — BURNABY - NEL-SON.

Westbound to Vancouver: To Larwill Bus Depot— VAN-DEPOT; to Kingsway and Broadway—VAN-BWAY: to Kingsway and

Govt. and Cariboo for Kootenay Loop: 7.23 a.m. and .52 past hour until 12.52 p.m., then at 2.02 p.m. and .02 past hour until final trip at 12.53 a.m. Alternate trips from Sapperton at .45 past evennumbered hours, until 12.45 p.m.; then 2.55 p.m. and .55 past even-numbered hours until last trip at 12.46 a.m. From 16th and Cumberland at .45 past odd-numbered hours until 11.45 a.m., then 1.55 p.m. and .55 past oddnumbered hours until final trip at 11.55 p.m.

Extension from 16th and Cumberland. A small vehicle will travel from 16th and Cumberland via 16th, 1st Ave., Wedgewood, Hill and Elwell to Cumberland, returning over the same route. Passengers will be picked up and let off on Elwell Street only. (See (G), Burnaby Map, see page 10.)

Schedule: Fi trips daily and Saturday; three trips Sundays and holidays.

Eighth Ave. The Eighth Ave.-2nd Street (New Westminster) service' will be extended on Eighth Ave. from its present terminus at 20th, to 23rd Street, looping via 8th, 23rd, Edinburgh and 22nd. (See (H), Burnaby Map, page 10.)

Schedule: 20-minute service, with 10-minute service in rush hours.

Leaving times are unchanged except at 23rd and Eighth Avenue, where buses will leave one minute earlier than previously. Times from this terminus will be at .09, .29 and .49 past hour.

Hastings-Bainbridge buses will travel from Hastings and Kootenay via Hastings, Sperling, Broadway and Bainbridge to Lougheed Highway, returning over the same route. (See (I), Burnaby Map, page 10.)

Schedule: Weekdays and Saturdays — Lv. Kootenay Loop for Bainbridge and Lougheed: on hour and half hour. Lv. Bainbridge and Lougheed for Kootenay Loop: .17 and .47 past hour. Sundays: Lv. Kootenay Loop for Bainbridge and Lougheed at .20 past hour until 12.20 p.m., then 1.30

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Weekdays and Saturdays -6 a.m. and 7 a.m., then half hourly to 9 a.m., then hourly unt' 3 p.m., then half-hourly until 5 p.m., then hourly again until midnight. Sundays—8 a.m. and hour-

ly thereafter until midnight.

Lv. Kootenay via Willingdon

Weekdays and Saturdays -6.30 a.m., 7.15, 7.45, 8.15, 9.30 and hourly thereafter until 2.30 p.m., then 3.45, 4.15, 4.45, 5.15, 5.30, 6.15, 6.30 and hourly thereafter until 12.30 midnight. Note: Buses leaving the Loop at .15 and .45 go to Springer and Douglas Road only.

Sundays — 7.30 a.m. and hourly thereafter until 12.30 midnight.

Smith buses will travel from Hastings and Kootenay via Kootenay, Pender, Boundary, Grandview Highway, Smith, Burke, Boundary, 45th and thence to the Joyce and Kingsway loop. (See (E), Burnaby Map, page 10.)

NOTE: The connecting services from 17th and Boundary, and from Lougheed and Boundary to Broadway and Renfrew will remain.

Fares: Either Vancouver or Burnaby fares will be accepted on the Boundary Road section of this line.


Schedule: From Joyce Loop: Weekdays, Wednesdays and Saturdays, on the hour and half hour; in rush, at 10, 30 and 50 minutes past the hour. From Kootenay Loop: Weekdays, Wednesdays and Saturdays, every half hour at 2 and 32 minutes past the hour; in rush at 2, 22 and 42 minutes past the hour.

NOTE: Connecting services will continue to operate from 17th and Boundary, and from Lougheed Highway and Boundary to the Renfrew loop at Broadway and Renfrew.

Government-Cumberland-Sapperton service will operate from Hastings and Kootenay via Hastings, Sperling, Broadway, Bainbridge, Government, Phillips, Government to Cariboo; thence alternate trips will travel via Cariboo, Armstrong, and Cumberland to 16th; and via Government and North Road to Sapperton. (See (F), Burnaby Map, page 10.)

Schedule: Hourly service between Hastings and Kootenay and Government and Cariboo; two-hourly service between there and Sapperton and between there and 16th and Cumberland. In rush hours, 30 minute service to Government and Cariboo and 60 minute service to Sapperton and to 16th and Cumberland.

Weekdays and Saturdays -Lv. Kootenay Loop for Govt and Cariboo: 30-minute rush service at .20 and .50 (Continued on Page 11)

• On the Burnaby-Edmonds line, the area on Kingsway between McKercher and Nelson will be considered either Zone 1 or Zone 2, whichever means the lower fare.

• On the Government-Cumberland - Sapperton line, the area on Sperling between Broadway and Adair will be considered either Zone 1 or Zone 2, whichever means the lower fare.

• On the Gilmore-Willingdon line, the area between Douglas Road and Norland, on Sprott, will be considered either Zone 1 or Zone 2, whichever means the lower fare.
