Then come on down to Stanley Park, now at its springtime loveliest!

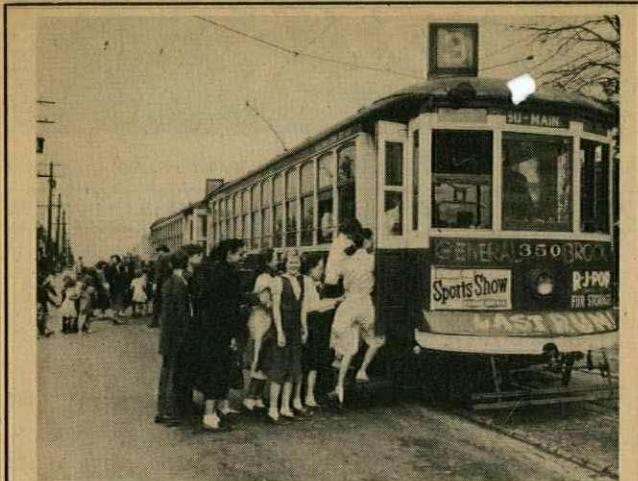
Beginning next Sunday, you can get handily to any point of interest in the park—for a "slack" ticket—via our 'round the park bus service.

Other regulations are also unchanged: No transfers can be issued or accepted, and no stop-overs are allowed. As mentioned, standard fares for adults and children will apply: "slacks" at 4 for 45c, or 13c cash; children, tickets at 5 for 25c or 5c cash.
