
8 DAVIE - 19 KINGSWAY


Eastbound 19 Kingsway trolley coach service will operate downtown via Robson, Burrard, Smithe (instead of Robson as at present), Granville, Cordova, Carrall, new Keefer Diversion and Keefer Street to Main. Then along present route . . . Westbound 8 Davie route will remain unchanged.



22 KNIGHT — 23 MACDONALD

22 Knight buses, eastbound through downtown area, will rum via Burrard, Dunsmuir, Beatty, Pender, new Keefer Diversion (instead of Pender as at present) and Gore (instead of Jackson). Then along present route . . . Westbound 23 Macdonald buses will operate downtown via Prior and Gore (instead of Jackson) then via present route.

Note: During morning and afternoon rush hours, alternate Terminal Avenue leg of this service will run on Main Street (instead of along Gore).



6 FRASER — 15 CAMBIE

Eastbound 6 Fraser trolley coach service will operate downtown via Cambie Bridge, Robson, Seymour, Cordova, Carrall, new Keefer Diversion (instead of Pender) and Keefer Street to Main, then on regular route . . . Westbound 15 Cambie buses will run on Pender, Granville, Smithe (instead of Robson), Cambie, Robson and Cambie Bridge.

Minor Changes


A FEW additional changes in downtown Vancouver transit routes will be made Monday, Aug. 26, when the City's one-way street program goes into operation.


The BCE's basic program of changes was completed July 26, and service is operating smoothlyso these additional changes on four routes are only minor in nature and should cause no confusion for our passengers. For the most part they involve using the new Keefer Diversion, just east of Carrall, instead of Pender Street, for eastbound movements.

Here are the four routes that will be affected:

- 6 Fraser 15 Cambie
- 8 Davie 19 Kingsway
- 22 Knight 23 Macdonald
- Burnaby Edmonds Burnaby Stride

Maps of the new downtown routes for these lines are carried in this issue of The Buzzer, together with a large map showing all downtown routings and stops to help you make more convenient use of the transit system.





BURNABY EDMONDS — BURNABY STRIDE

Eastbound Burnaby Edmonds-Stride buses will operate in downtown Vancouver via Dunsmuir, Beatty (instead of Cambie as at present), Pender, new Keefer Diversion at Carrall, and Keefer Street to Main (instead of Pender to Main). Then they will proceed on present route . . . Westbound Burnaby Edmonds-Stride bus route will remain unchanged.
