

SUNDAY & HOLIDAY PASSES

An economical way to discover your city is with a Sunday & Holiday Pass. For \$1.25 adult, 35¢ child the pass can be purchased and used in Zone B as well as Zone A without extra payment for crossing the zone boundary.

The pass may also be purchased and used on the 'Round-Bark Stanley Park special service. Travel on Seabus is also included, but passes may be purchased only on buses. This pass is not valid on charter services, Exhibition Park Race Track services or Empire Stadium non-stop services.

Bus to school

No matter what campus you happen to be attending this year — UBC, SFU or BCIT — the Greater Vancouver Transit System provides fast frequent service to take you there.

Regular service for UBC is provided by the 10th-UBC/Hastings, Forty-First, Forty-Ninth, and UBC/Spanish Banks routes. In addition there is the 286 North Shore-UBC service, for UBC passengers only. Drop-offs are not made until the bus reaches the University gates. Passengers may board the 286 at any regular route stop in North Vancouver plus an additional stop at Georgia & Bute to pick up transferring West Vancouver students, then non-stop to UBC.

In addition to the above we have two special routes serving UBC from Richmond. One departs Cook & No. 3 Rd. at 7:33 a.m. and again at 8:35 a.m. Also, from Sea-Bus at Granville Waterfront Station, two trips depart at 7:50 a.m. and 8:50 a.m. Please note these "specials" are for UBC passengers only.

There are three regular bus routes providing service to B.C.'s mountain top campus, Simon Fraser University — the 35 Westridge from Kootenay Loop, the 58 SFU-Edmonds from Edmonds Loop and the 145 Burnaby Mountain service from Loughheed Mall.

Bus service to and from the B.C. Institute of Technology is provided by the following routes:

30 Willingdon — operates between Kootenay Loop and Marine Drive at Patterson with stops at BCIT on Willingdon in both directions. Rush hour service is every 15 minutes; otherwise every 30 minutes.

32 Grandview — operates between Kootenay Loop and Edmonds Loop with stops at BCIT on Canada Way in both directions. Rush hour service is every 30 minutes; otherwise every 60 minutes.

820 Canada Way — operates between New Westminster and downtown Vancouver with stops at BCIT on Canada Way in both directions. Service throughout the day is every 15 minutes with 30 minute service after 8:50 p.m.

Timetables for all bus routes are available on campus. Transit Guides including an overall map of the transit system are available for 25¢ at Eaton's, The Bay and Woodward's. For more details call transit information at 324-3211.

PNE AREA GETS NEW RESIDENT PERMIT PARKING SYSTEM

Anyone planning to attend sports events, concerts, weekend horseracing or any other major event at the PNE Grounds is encouraged to take the bus.

Effective September 13, any vehicle parked on a residential street or lane during major PNE events must display either a Resident Parking Permit Decal or a Visitor Pass. Parking Permit Decals and Visitor Passes are available only to residents of the permit area bounded by Nanaimo & Charles Streets, Boundary Road and the Waterfront.

Police will be enforcing the Resident Parking Permit system and ticketing vehicles not displaying a valid Parking Permit. The minimum fine is \$25.00.
