# Underground access to downtown SkyTrain stations

An underground walkway now connects Burrard Station with Bentall Centre, offering passengers an alternative means of entering and leaving the station.

The walkway, lined with shops and services, leads to the station's fare machine level. The two fare-paid zones are on lower levels. Plans are underway for similar walkways to connect the station with the Royal Centre and Park Place.

The Granville Station is connected to The Bay basem by a store-lined walkway. The station can also be accessed dire from the store's Seymour Street entrance.

An underground walkway connects the northwest corner of Dunsmuir and Beatty with Stadium Station's underground concourse and the fare machine and fare-paid zones.

An underground walkway connecting the Waterfront Station with the newly restored Sinclair Centre will be open to commuters from February 20 until EXPO opens. After EXPO the walkway will re-open for general use. The Sinclair Centre, a federal government complex which includes the former main post office, provides access to Granville, Hastings and Howe Streets.
