

West Vancouver "Blue Bus" service changes

effective November 2

250 Horseshoe Bay

The schedule has been adjusted to reflect changes in running times or to better meet passenger demands. Sunday and holiday evening service has been adjusted to more closely match weekday and Saturday services.

251 Upper Levels Queens/252 Inglewood

The Sunday/holiday schedule has been revised slightly to better match weekday and Saturday evening services.

253 Cypress Park/254 British Properties

Schedules of connecting trips to Vancouver have been adjusted slightly.

257 Horseshoe Bay Express

Because of low ridership figures, buses will no longer operate between the Gleneagles Park and Ride Lot and Marine Drive at Gallagher. There will be an additional evening trip from Horseshoe Bay to Park Royal, leaving Horseshoe Bay at 6:16 p.m.

258 West Vancouver

P.M. peak trips from UBC will leave four minutes earlier, at 3:36 and 4:36 p.m.

"Blue Bus" service for Lions Bay

259 Horseshoe Bay/Lions Bay

Commencing November 2, the #259 route will provide service between Lions Bay and downtown Vancouver, and connections to the entire Vancouver Regional Transit System, including SkyTrain and SeaBus.

Buses will leave the Lions Bay Underpass at 6:55 a.m., 9:20 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, and at 9:20 a.m. on Saturdays. At Horseshoe Bay they will become a #250 or #257 and proceed to downtown Vancouver.

From downtown Vancouver (Georgia & Homer), passengers will board a #250 or #257 at 8:15 a.m., 5:05 p.m. or 7:35 p.m., Monday through Friday, and 5:38 or 7:35 p.m. on Saturdays. At Horseshoe Bay Ferry Terminal the bus will become a #259 and continue on to Lions Bay Underpass.

Lions Bay residents are asked to watch their mail during the last week of October for a convenient, wallet-sized #259 timetable and a special two-for-one coupon. The coupon is valid for use on any service day, Monday, November 2 through Saturday, November 14. We hope you'll use it to see for yourself just how far you can go with a transit connection.

Whether you ride the Bus, SkyTrain or SeaBus, or a combination of these transit modes, FareCard offers the most convenient way to pay your fare. When boarding a bus simply show your Card to the operator.

When boarding SkyTrain or SeaBus, walk directly to the platform or terminal - no waiting.

And check these other benefits:

NO RIDE LIMIT - as many rides as you want: daily, weekly, monthly (see zone information)

ECONOMICAL - You'll save if you take more than 20 peak period round trips monthly.

TRANSFERABLE - You can lend your FareCard when you're not using it.**

UPGRADEABLE - Pay for extra zones if you need them with an addfare at the time of travel.

Buy the Zone

1 ZONE LOCAL (Yellow FareCard) \$46.00

For peak travel in one zone only, and off peak travel in all zones.

2 ZONES URBAN (Red FareCard) \$62.00

For peak travel over the urban zone boundary, and off peak travel in all zones.

2 ZONES SUBURBAN (Blue FareCard) \$62.00

For peak travel over the suburban zone boundary, and off peak travel in all zones.

3 ZONES SUPER (Green FareCard) \$88.00

For travel in all zones at all times.

CONCESSION (Brown FareCard) \$27.00

Children aged 5-13 years, students with valid GoCard, seniors 65 and over with proof of age. For travel in all zones at all times.
