

52 Around the Park service will be wheelchair accessible

When the 52 Around the Park route recommences its Saturday, Sunday and holiday service on Saturday, April 6 it will be accessible at selected stops to wheelchair passengers and those who have difficulty climbing aboard a conventional bus.

Check the accompanying map for regular and accessible stop locations.

Please note that some stops within the park may not be accessible until some time after the implementation of the service. Accessible stops will show the international wheelchair decal.



Buses will leave Stanley Park Loop every hour on the hour from 10 am to 7 pm. Additional service will be provided when fine weather and special events create demand.

The route will again be extended to allow passengers to board and alight outside the park, particularly at stops on Denman Street.

From Chilco Loop buses will travel via Alberni, Denman, Morton, Beach, Stanley Park Drive, North Lagoon Drive, Georgia, Gilford and Alberni.

The complete circle tour takes approximately 30 minutes. Regular fares and transfers apply.

A reminder about HandyPass

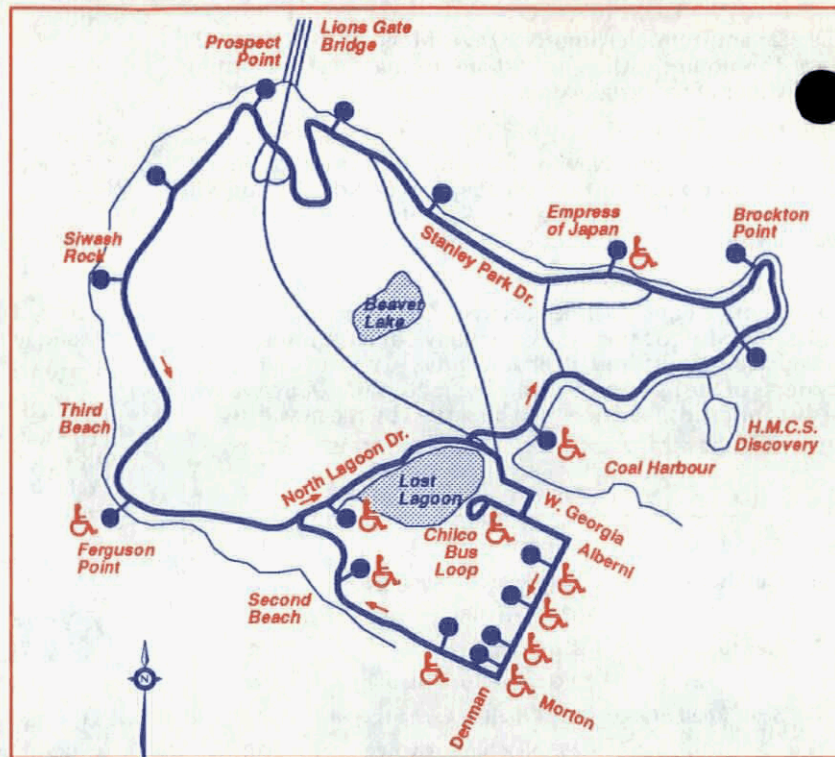
If a disability prevents you from using regular buses you may apply for a HandyPass.

HandyPass entitles the registered holder to travel at Concession fares on buses, SeaBus and SkyTrain and to have an attendant travel free of charge.
