A passenger with a HandyPass pays a Concession fare and is entitled to take an attendant along free of charge.

A passenger with a MSS, CNIB or War Amps card in addition to a HandyPass, rides free and is entitled to take an attendant along free of charge.

This will improve transit service to the ferries for residents in North Surrey, North Delta, Langley, Burnaby, Coquitlam and New Westminster. Peak period buses will be routed through Tilbury Island Industrial Park. Some #319 trips will be extended to provide hourly service between Ladner Exchange and Scott Road Station via Scottsdale Mall, to replace this section of the previous #640 service.

## SkyTrain riders: Interim Surrey bus routes, March 28 to April 10

You will be able to use the three new SkyTrain stations beginning March 28, but bus service will continue to operate to Scott Road Station until April 10.

Because of continuing construction around Surrey Central Station, the minor re-routings listed in the March 11 Buzzer will not be implemented. Buses will continue to stop on 134A St. & 102 Ave. to pick up and drop-off passengers, but will use the new transit exchange with the introduction of the service changes on April 11.

Buses heading for Surrey Central Station (Whalley Exchange) will follow their regular routes, except for the 321 Scott Road Station and 326/329 Surrey Central Station. These north-bound buses will stop on King George Hwy. at King George Station, then continue via King George Hwy., 102 Ave., and 134A St. to Surrey Central Station.

During peak hours, the 390 White Rock Centre, 395 Willowbrook and 502 Brookswood will be re-routed to serve Surrey Central Station. Buses will travel via King George I lwy. and 102 Ave. (stopping at Bay #4), then continue to terminus.

#### Join in the SkyTrain celebration

Shortly after 5:00 am on Monday, March 28, three new SkyTrain stations will open and you're invited to join in the celebration on the first day of service. The first 5,000 customers will receive commemorative First Rider certificates and souvenirs and prizes sponsored by Surrey Place Mall, the City of Surrey and BC Transit.
