

New SFU Transit Exchange opens

The new transit exchange will begin operation with the first bus on Monday, April 11. Located just east of the Administration Building, the spacious new facility will meet both present and future needs.

All buses heading to and from the new exchange pass through the Transportation Centre (just north of the Security Office) where passengers will be dropped off at east side stops and picked up at the west side stop. Only Bay #3 is not accessible to wheelchairs. Watch for further information in The Buzzer before the Fall term commences.

Ride around the Park, weekends and holidays

The **52 Around the Park** service that operates Saturdays, Sundays and holidays until October, has commenced. A lift-equipped bus leaves Stanley Park Loop every hour, on the hour, from 10 am to 7 pm. Additional service is provided when fine weather and special events create demand. From Chilco Loop buses travel via Alberni, Denman, Morton, Beach, Stanley Park Drive, North Lagoon Drive, Stanley Park Drive, North Lagoon Drive, Georgia, Chilco and into Loop. Regular fares and transfers apply.





19 Stanley Park will be re-routed

The #19 diesel bus service that has operated to Stanley Park's Chilco Loop daily since December will follow a new, permanent route. Buses heading for the Park will no longer be routed via Alberni, between Denman and Chilco, but will continue along Georgia and into Stanley Park. After the Pipeline Road stop they will turn left under the Causeway and on to North Lagoon Drive; then back along Georgia to Chilco and into the Loop.

Monday through Friday, the 19 Downtown/Metrotown Station trolley service will continue to loop downtown via Pender, Howe, Dunsmuir, Burrard and Pender, allowing passengers for Stanley Park to transfer to the 19 Stanley Park diesel at Pender and Granville.

On Saturday, Sunday and holidays, the 19 Stanley Park/Metrotown will provide diesel service all along the route, with no transfer necessary.
