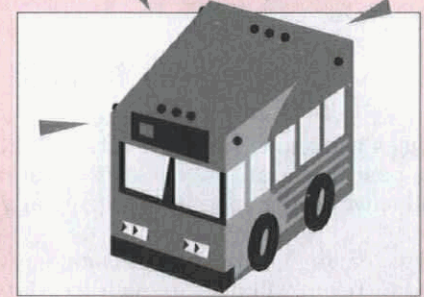

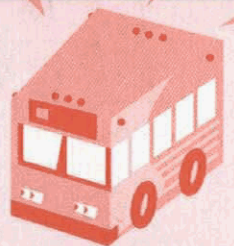

to improve service reliability

North Vancouver Schedule and route changes, effective November 10

Route or schedule adjustments to improve the reliability of North Vancouver bus service



210 Vancouver/Upper Lynn Valley ♿

292 Upper Lynn Valley ♿

#210 buses will leave Burrard Station at 20 and 50 minutes past the hour. Two new #210 morning peak trips will leave Underwood at Dempsey at 7:44 and 7:48 am.

#292 trips leaving Underwood & Dempsey at 7:01, 7:31 and 8:01 am will operate as a *210 Vancouver*. *292 Upper Lynn Valley* service from Vancouver will not change. Trips will leave Burrard Station at 4:35 and 5:05 pm.

211 Seymour/Phibbs Exch/Vancouver ♿

290 Deep Cove ♿

290 Vancouver trips will operate as a *211 Vancouver*. Afternoon service to Deep Cove on the *290 Deep Cove* will be unchanged.

Throughout the day, #211 departure times from Panorama at Naughton will change slightly.

212 Phibbs Exchange/Deep Cove ♿

Weekday departure times from Panorama at Naughton will change slightly.

Sunday and holiday service will operate until later in the evening and more trips will be added.

214 Phibbs Exchange/Vancouver/Blueridge ♿

Buses will leave Phibbs Exchange daily at 47 minutes past the hour, except during peak hours when there is more frequent service.

Weekday buses will leave Sechelt at Hyannis on the hour. In the morning peak, an additional trip will leave at 7:45 for Phibbs Exchange.

215 Indian River/Phibbs Exchange ♿

Buses will leave Phibbs Exchange daily at 17 minutes past the hour, except during peak hours when there is more frequent service.

From Inlet Crescent at Indian River, buses will leave at 30 minutes past the hour. In the PM peak, an additional trip will leave Phibbs Exchange at 4:02 pm. The *215 Indian River* will operate from Bay #8 at Phibbs Exchange.

218 Capilano College/Phibbs Exchange ♿

An additional trip will leave Capilano College at 6:08 am. Throughout the day, a number of *239 Phibbs Exchange* buses will leave Phibbs Exchange as a *218 Capilano College* trip.

229 Lonsdale Quay via Westlynn ♿

On weekdays, departure times from Phibbs Exchange and from Lynn Valley Road at Mountain Hwy will change slightly.

230 Upper Lonsdale/Lonsdale Quay ♿

On weekday evenings, three trips from Lonsdale Quay will be added: leaving at 6:42 to 15th Street and at 7:03 and 7:31 to 23rd Street.

On Sundays and holidays after 12:30 pm, buses will no longer layover at Osborne at Lonsdale. They will continue on to Prospect at Rockland.

During the PM peak-period, departure times will be adjusted so that buses leave slightly earlier.

A hive of activity!

B-Line capacity was boosted in September

Ridership increased even more

B-Line service is very popular, very successful. So successful that in spite of the fact September service began with considerably more capacity than at the end of the previous school year, we have since had to add more trips. And we will be adding still more when extra buses and drivers become available.

Looking farther down the road to 1998, we are already reacting to revised customer demand forecasts and recommending more service improvements.

Construction of the new B-Line stop at Sasamat, designed to service passengers travelling between Point Grey and central Broadway, SkyTrain etc. has unfortunately been delayed by the recent municipal strike. We hope it will be completed by the end of the year.

Sunday service on November 11

From King George Station the first and last trains leave at 7:08 am and 11:38 pm.

From Waterfront Station the first and last trains leave at 7:50 am and 12:15 am.

From Lonsdale Quay, the first and last SeaBuses leave at 8:02 am and 11:02 pm.

From Vancouver, the first and last SeaBuses leave at 8:16 am and 11:16 pm.

Single zone fares apply system-wide on holidays and a DayPass or valid FareCard will allow unrestricted travel throughout the day.

Please stand behind the red line

Clearly visible red lines have been installed on bus floors, just behind the driver. We ask that you stand behind this line to ensure that the driver can see the rear view mirror and what's happening on the right side of the bus. He/she needs an unrestricted view to operate the bus safely. Thanks for your cooperation.
