Wheelchair and Scooter passengers

SkyTrain and #640 bus service to Tsawwassen Ferry Terminal

Please remember that the #640 operates to and from only one SkyTrain station: Scott Road. Since the elevator at Scott Road is on the east side of the station and isn't accessible to conventional buses, wheelchair passengers wishing to board the #640 can detrain at Surrey Central Station, take the #330 to Scott Road Station and transfer to the #640. #640 passengers wishing to board SkyTrain can transfer to the #330 at Scott Road and board SkyTrain at Surrey Central Station. Alternatively, passengers may phone Surrey HandyDART at 591-8234 before starting their trip and request shuttle service between the west and east sides of Scott Road Station. Surrey HandyDART office hours are 8 am to 4 pm, Monday to Friday; 9 am to 5 pm, Saturday, Sunday and holidays.

West Vancouver "Blue Buses" provide a #250 bus from downtown Vancouver (Homer & Georgia), via Marine Drive every 15 minutes during rush hours and every 30 minutes in non-peak hours. In addition, the #257 Express operates from downtown Vancouver, via the Upper Levels Highway, every 30 minutes during rush hours and every two hours at other times, including weekends and holidays.

Prepaid fares go hand in hand with Bus/Seabus/SkyTrain services to provide the ultimate in holiday season travel. Enjoy boarding for trips to the region's major shopping areas without having to be aware of the coins or notes you'll need for your fare, and think of the possible savings. In addition to getting you to and from work, any valid FareCard is good for unlimited travel throughout the system; weekdays after 6:30 pm and all day Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. What's more, when you aren't using your FareCard, someone else you know can be. It's transferable.

FareSaver tickets and DayPasses also have their advantages. On books of 10 tickets you save \$1.25 to \$2. For \$6 a day, a DayPass offers unlimited travel throughout the system. DayPasses for immediate use are available at ticket machines. Scratch & Ride DayPasses are available in advance at FareDealers.

Those who qualify for Concession* fares can purchase a FareCard that offers unlimited travel for \$35. *Children 5-13, Secondary students with GoCards. Seniors 65+ with proof of age, and handyPass holders.
