APEC Conference • Downtown Bus Service Plan, November 19 to 26

During the APEC Conference, BC Transit bus services in downtown Vancouver will be subject to rerouting and occasional delays. The objective of the APEC organizers is to minimize the impact of conference activities on traffic and we will be working closely with them to minimize disruptions to our passengers. The bus service plan for downtown Vancouver consists of :

- rerouting of all services that use Burrard Street
- relocation of finish/start locations (termini) for suburban bus services
- "short-turning" of West Vancouver, North Vancouver, West End and Stanley Park services during Burrard corridor closures.

At certain times the Burrard Street Corridor will be closed to cross traffic

West Vancouver, North Vancouver, West End and Stanley Park bus routes will be affected by these closures. Rerouting will depend upon the extent of the delay and will essentially involve terminating services either east or west of Burrard.

SkyTrain will increase mid-day frequency (a train every 3-4 minutes instead of every 5), and extend the hours of rush hour service to accommodate conference visitors and residents who choose not to drive during the week.

Surrey Schedule & Route changes begin Nov 17 P.3

Some Sunday SkyTrain service will be affected by guideway maintenance

SkyTrain maintenance will be carried out on 9 or 10 weekends in the coming six months. After almost 12 years of service, it is necessary to renew and upgrade the anchoring of the Linear Induction Motor (LIM) reaction rail, the flat aluminum-clad rail in the centre of the track, in and around several stations. At these locations the LIM rail has borne the force of the acceleration and braking of well over a million trains.

This work cannot be accomplished within the short nightly shut-down period, so must be done during the day while trains are rerouted on to the adjacent track and train frequency is reduced. The affect on service will depend on the location of the work and the distance between the crossover tracks. On some dates the trains may be up to 15 minutes apart on portions of the line, or be held up for only a few minutes at selected stations. Sundays, when the least number of passengers use the system and the least number will be inconvenienced. have been chosen to do the work. We have made efforts to avoid the peak Christmas shopping season and dates when major sporting events and other special events Continued on page 2

would require more than usual service. We will also do our best to minimize delays and inconvenience,

- Planned dates are Dec 7. Jan 25. Feb 1/8/15/22. Mar 22 and 29 and Apr 26. These dates are subject to change. Service will normally be affected for the entire day.
- Continuing information will be supplied through The Buzzer, "Rider Alert" leaflets, station notices and the digital signs on SkyTrain platforms.
- On Sundays when work is being performed, please watch platform destination signs and listen for announcements, especially at stations where trains are running in both directions on one track.

Sunday, Dec 7: Work will occur at New Westminster Station (westbound track), but service frequency will remain at a near-normal 5-6 minutes.
