

SPRING SERVICE CHANGES, EFFECTIVE MONDAY, APRIL 10

9 Boundary/Alma

Until September, all trips will terminate at Alma. Customers wishing to continue to UBC should transfer to a #10 or 99 B-Line at 10th Avenue.

22 Knight/Macdonald (L)

Additional peak-period service, Monday to Friday.

- One additional morning trip, Monday to Friday, will arrive at Burrard & Robson at approximately 5:45 am for 6:00 am work starts.

- Six additional evening trips from downtown Vancouver to Macdonald at 16th.

Macdonald express trips will operate every 7-8 minutes until 6:30 pm and every 10 minutes until 7:30 pm.

25 Brentwood/UBC (L)

While UBC is not in session, morning peak-period service will be slightly reduced.

28 Joyce Station/Phibbs Exchange/ Capilano College (L)

Reduced summer service to Capilano College.

As of May 1, two trips leaving Phibbs Exchange at 10:02 and 10:17 am will be discontinued until September. Customers can continue to use the other #28 or the #239 services between Phibbs Exchange and Capilano College.

49 Metrotown Station/Dunbar Loop/UBC (L)

New this spring and summer. #49 will provide peak-period service to UBC. Trips are every 20 minutes until full service resumes in September.

The 4:15 pm trip from UBC will be discontinued.

99 B-Line (B) (L)

Until September, morning peak-period service to UBC will be reduced slightly. Two westbound trips from Broadway Station between 7:00 and 8:00 am will be discontinued and the remaining trips will be adjusted to provide a bus every 5 minutes.

142 SFU/Edmonds (L)

Effective May 1, all service will be discontinued between SFU and Edmonds Station until September.

143 SFU/Coquitlam Station

The 9:05 am trip from Coquitlam Station will continue to operate throughout the spring and summer this year. Service expansion is planned for September.

145 Lougheed Mall/SFU/Scott Road Stn (L) (B)

Until September, the last two morning trips from Scott Road Station and from SFU will be discontinued. In the afternoon, the first and last trips will be discontinued.

148 loco/New Westminster Station (L)

From May 13 to September 4, several weekend and holiday trips will be extended to White Pine Beach at Sasamat Lake. Watch for weekday service to White Pine Beach beginning June 19!

130 Metrotown Station/Kootenay Loop (L)

Additional Monday to Friday evening service. Between approximately 6:30 and 9:00 pm, the #130 will provide twice as many trips, operating every 15 minutes instead of every half-hour.

133 SFU/Metrotown Station (Express) (L)

Summer service will operate every 60 minutes. The 8:10 and 9:10 pm trips from Metrotown will be discontinued. From SFU, the 2:56 pm and 3:56 pm trips will be discontinued.

135 SFU/Stanley Park (L) (B)

During SFU's summer semester, peak-period service will be slightly reduced. Two trips from Hastings & Kootenay, between 7:50 and 9:00 am, will not run and remaining trips will be adjusted to provide 10-minute service.

236 Lonsdale Quay/Grouse Mountain/ Pemberton Heights (L)

Increased daytime frequency, from every 30 to every 15 minutes, will begin earlier this year and continue until October 9.

This will address the demand for service to North Shore tourist destinations and improve capacity between Lonsdale Quay and Grouse Mountain.

(L) Accessible service (B) Bike Rack-equipped

411 Steveston/Vancouver

Customers will benefit through increased frequency (every 15 minutes) and reduced crowding during peak periods, and by bypassing Richmond Centre and travelling via the No. 2 and Arthur Laing bridges, the #411 will be more attractive to passengers destined for downtown, UBC or Vancouver International Airport. The first trip from Steveston will leave at 5:31 am, arriving downtown at 6:20.

480 Steveston/UBC

The #480 will continue operating to UBC throughout the spring and summer. Service expansion is planned for the Fall.

The Better Way to get
to the Sun Run

Participating in the Sun Run? Plan your pre-run strategy now

On Sunday, April 16 you can drive into town and compete with thousands for parking spots or you can relax and take transit.

With a later starting time for the Sun Run this year, 9 am, the first SkyTrain will still offer earlier start times.

The first SkyTrain will leave King George Station at 6:38 am, arriving downtown at approximately 7:15. Full "rush hour" service, with trains running every two to three minutes, will operate during the hour before the Run. Extra trains will also be provided after the Run to get you home as quickly as possible.

To assist you in getting to your colour-coded starting area as soon as possible, organizers request that entrants with RED, GREEN AND WHITE RUN NUMBERS PLEASE EXIT AT GRANVILLE STATION. Only those with YELLOW NUMBERS SHOULD EXIT AT BURRARD STATION. If you have any questions, look for a Sun Run volunteer who will direct you to the correct colour zone.

SeaBus service from Lonsdale Quay will commence earlier than last year, at 6:32 am. From then until 12:32, 15-minute service will be provided, followed by 30-minute service until 11:30 pm. The last sailing from Waterfront Station will be at 11:16 pm.

Bus services will be augmented to get you downtown before 9:00 am and to get you home again.

In previous years over 7,000 people have taken advantage of SkyTrain service and research indicated that as many as 45 per cent of all Sun Runners used transit services.

West Coast Express will also provide service to get you downtown in time for the Run. A train leaving Mission at 7 am is scheduled to arrive at Waterfront Station at 8:13. The return trip will leave Waterfront Station at 2 pm.
