Then just prior to boarding a transit vehicle for the first free ride on each of the two days you choose, scratch the month and date. GradPass is not transferable: only the person who signs it is eligible to use it.

Additional Bus and SeaBus services when the Lions Gate Bridge is closed

The Lions Gate Bridge will be closed periodically for reconstruction of the roadbed during the next several months, **beginning Friday**, **May 12**.

This will include several full and partial weekend closures and numerous weeknight closures.

The following additional services and reroutes are designed to facilitate customer travel:

#230 Lonsdale

The 30-minute service on Lonsdale will be augmented. This more frequent #230 service, in addition to **#229** service, will provide customers with 15-minute service between Lonsdale Quay and 23rd Street.

#239 Park Royal/Lonsdale

When the Lions Gate Bridge is closed on Saturdays, customers wishing to travel to downtown Vancouver from Park Royal may take the #239 to Lonsdale and connect with SeaBus, or when SeaBus is not running, connect with a **shuttle bus** to downtown Vancouver via the Second Narrows Bridge.

#240 15th Street/Park Royal

Westbound service will be rerouted to Park Royal Shopping Centre.

Shuttle buses will operate to Lonsdale Quay and SeaBus, or when SeaBus is not running, with shuttles operating to downtown Vancouver.

#240 Waterfront Station Shuttle

This additional service will operate when SeaBus is running, providing customers with timed local service along Georgia Street, between Chilco Loop and Waterfront Station, to and from SeaBus.

#242 Lonsdale Quay/Upper Lonsdale/ Park Royal

This additional service will provide #242 OWL (Late Night) service from Upper Lonsdale, via Lonsdale Quay to Park Royal Shopping Centre. It is scheduled to make timed connections at Lonsdale Quay with the #242

Downtown Vancouver shuttle, operating to downtown Vancouver via the Second Narrows Bridge.

Customers will be able to travel between North Vancouver and Downtown Vancouver when SeaBus is not operating.

#242 Vancouver/ Lonsdale Quay Shuttle

When SeaBus is not running, this shuttle will operate along Georgia Street, connecting Chilco Loop and Lonsdale Quay, via the Second Narrows Bridge. This will provide downtown Vancouver to North Shore travel.

#246 Lonsdale Quay/Highland/Park Royal

When the Lions Gate Bridge is closed on **Saturday**, all westbound #246 Park Royal buses that normally operate to downtown Vancouver during the daytime will go to Park Royal Shopping Centre instead.

From there, customers may transfer to **shuttle buses** to Lonsdale Quay and SeaBus, or when SeaBus is not operating, to **shuttle buses** running to downtown Vancouver via the Second Narrows Bridge.

SeaBus

During Lions Gate Bridge closures, SeaBus will operate as follows:

MONDAY TO FRIDAY

When 8 pm bridge closures occur, SeaBus will operate on a 30-minute frequency until the last sailings leave Lonsdale Quay at 12:32 am and Waterfront at 12:46 am. SATURDAY

During bridge closures, SeaBus will operate with a 30-minute frequency from the first sailings (leaving Lonsdale Quay at 6:02 am and Waterfront at 6:16 am). Sailings will be every 15 minutes from 10:02 am until 6:02 pm, and every 30 minutes until the last sailings from Lonsdale Quay at 12:32 am, and Waterfront at 12:46 am.

SUNDAY

Service will be increased as follows during the midday period when the bridge is closed:

From every 30 minutes to every 15 minutes, 11:02 am until 6:32 pm from Lonsdale Quay, and 11:16 am until 6:46 pm from Waterfront.

All other sailings during the day will be every 30 minutes.
