

New route connecting Langley Centre with key destinations in Murrayville and Brookswood. Route combines with C61 to provide new two-way bus service through South Langley.








Changes to regional bus routes in Langley - effective December 23

320 Langley Centre / Surrey Central Station provides improved regional connections between Langley Centre and Surrey Central Station. For service in the Nicomekl River area, ride the new C60 and C61 routes.

501 Langley Centre / Surrey Central Station 590 Langley South / Surrey Central Station connects Langley Centre with Surrey Central Station. All 501/590 trips will serve Port Kells via 96 Avenue. There are minor adjustments to stopping procedures through North Surrey. For local service in South Langley, ride the new C60 and C61 routes. All 590 trips will continue to provide direct peak period service between Brookswood and Surrey Central Station (also see 502).

502 Aldergrove / Brookswood / Langley Centre / Surrey **Central Station** is a new direct service between Aldergrove and Surrey Central Station. This extended route replaces former 506 and 511 routes. There is more direct routing via Fraser Highway near Willowbrook Mall, with more trips to Aldergrove. Some 502 trips will continue to provide direct peak period service between Brookswood and Surrey Central Station (also see 501, 590).

509 Walnut Grove / Surrey Central Station offers direct service between Walnut Grove and Surrey via Highway #1.
