Effective September 12, Coast Mountain Bus Company began operating the #10. The #10 runs on Granville Street and extends to Richmond Centre via the Vancouver International Airport in both directions. In addition, the N19, which operates from Kingsway to Burnaby and New Westminster, is being extended to Surrey Central Station in North Surrey.
