- **NEW 84 VCC-Clark Station/UBC**

The new 84 bus will run between VCC-Clark and UBC along 6th Avenue, Great Northern Way, 2nd Avenue, 4th Avenue and Chancellor Boulevard.

- **44 Waterfront Station/UBC**

Improved service early evenings on weekdays

- **49 UBC/Dunbar Loop/Metrotown Station**

Improved midday service to UBC

- **143 Coquitlam Station/SFU**

Improved rush-hour service and extension of evening service to 10 p.m. for SFU students

- **480 Richmond Centre/UBC**

Improved evening service with larger buses for Richmond-bound students leaving UBC

- **99 B-Line Broadway Station/UBC, 99 S Broadway Station/UBC**

"Special" non-stop service between Broadway Station and UBC replaced with more trips on 99 B-Line to improve rush-hour service (up to every 2-3 minutes); improved Saturday midday service

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VCC-Clark Station and bus No. 84 service begin today

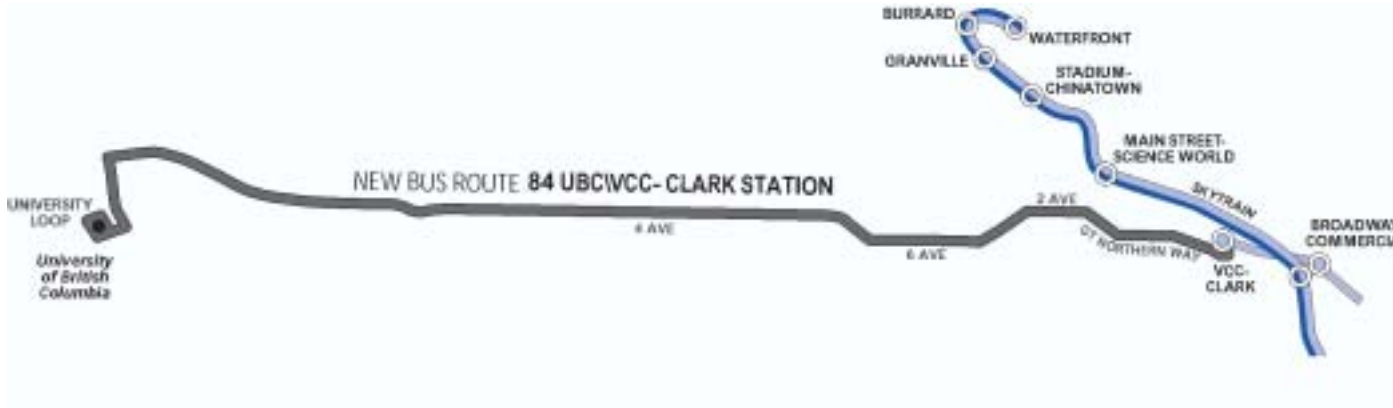
VCC-Clark Station opens today and becomes the 33rd SkyTrain station to serve regional communities.

The station, located in Vancouver on 6th Avenue at Keith Drive, is just two blocks north of Vancouver Community College.

New bus No. 84 travels between VCC-Clark Station and UBC

To coincide with the opening of the VCC-Clark Station, TransLink has added the No. 84 bus.

The 84 is a limited-stop service that travels between VCC-Clark Station and UBC along Great Northern Way, 2nd Avenue, 6th Avenue, 4th Avenue and Chancellor Boulevard.

This new bus route is particularly convenient for transit customers travelling along the False Creek south corridor.

Bus No. 84 will operate weekdays only, on a 15-minute service frequency.

- **Westbound**

First bus departs VCC-Clark Station at 6:45 a.m.
Final bus leaves at 6:45 p.m.

- **Eastbound**

First bus departs UBC 7:30 a.m.
Final bus departs UBC at 7:30 p.m.

VCC-Clark Station is located on 6th Avenue at Keith Drive, two blocks north of Vancouver Community College.

Travel time is approximately 30 minutes.
