# Routing change for #44 UBC/Downtown bus

Due to construction for the Canada Line in downtown Vancouver, the terminus for the #44 UBC will be changed, effective Monday, Oct. 16.

Beginning this date, the #44 UBC will no longer turn northbound off Hastings Street onto Granville. The bus will turn onto Seymour instead.

The #44 UBC terminus will move from its current location on Cordova (near side) at Seymour, to Seymour at Hastings (far side).

Please note: This change will remain in effect for approximately two years, until the Canada Line is completed.




