Bus service changes on December 16

We adjust our bus service four times a year to match the ebbs and flows of customer demand, and to ensure we're using our resources effectively. Here are the changes coming into effect on December 16, 2013. Generally, these changes occur in April, June, September and December.

This list is as accurate as of our publish date: please check translink.ca/servicechanges or call Transit Information at 604-953-3333 for corrections or further assistance. All changes are **PERMANENT** or **TEMPORARY**.

106 Metrotown Station/New Westminster Station PERMANENT

On weekdays, service between 4-6 p.m. will now run every 7-8 minutes to better match rider demand and reduce overcrowding.

159 Port Coquitlam Station/Braid Station PERMANENT

This service will be rerouted to provide a more reliable service.

178 Coquitlam Station/Port Moody Station PERMANENT

On weekdays, this new service will be running in addition to the C28 in the AM and PM peak periods. There will be eight new stops along David Ave. with new section routes on David Ave.

179 Johnson/Coquitlam Station PERMANENT

Due to low ridership, this service will be discontinued. For alternative service, see routes 178, 188, C28 and C29.

188 Port Coquitlam Station/Coquitlam Station PERMANENT

This new service will provide direct connections between Coquitlam and Port Coquitlam extending service to the Burke Mountain area.

189 Coast Meridian/Coquitlam Station PERMANENT

Due to low ridership, this service will be discontinued. For alternative service, see routes 188 and C38.

227 Lynn Valley Centre/Phibbs Exchange PERMANENT

This new service will operate with a community shuttle between Lynn Valley Centre and Phibbs Exchange via Lynn Canyon Park, seven days a week to better match ridership demand.

229 Lynn Valley Centre/Lonsdale Quay PERMANENT

This service will be renamed to "Lynn Valley Centre/Lonsdale Quay" and will end at Lynn Valley Centre along Lonsdale Ave., 29th St. and Lynn Valley Rd. A portion of its former route travelling between Lynn Valley and Phibbs Exchange will now be serviced by the 227 Community Shuttle.

335 Surrey Central Station/Guildford Exchange PERMANENT

On weekdays, two additional AM peak period trips will be added leaving Guildford Exchange to Surrey Central Station at 4:45 a.m. and 5:15 a.m. From Monday to Saturday, two additional evening trips will be added leaving Surrey Central to Guildford Exchange at 12:40 a.m. and 1:10 a.m.

531 Willowbrook/White Rock Centre PERMANENT

On weekends, this route will be serviced by a community shuttle to better match ridership demand.

620 Bridgeport/Station/Tsawwassen Ferry PERMANENT

Service has been modifed to better align with the Victoria (Swartz Bay) BC Ferries schedules.

C18 West Mall/UBC Loop PERMANENT

Service will operate every 30 minutes, seven days a week with a new route expanding the existing UBC service to the South Campus neighbourhood.

C20 Marine Drive/UBC Loop PERMANENT

Service will operate every 30 minutes, seven days a week with a change in routing to service the South Campus neighbourhood.

C21 Yaletown/Beach PERMANENT

Service will operate every 15 minutes, seven days a week with a slight change in routing to service between Yaletown Station and Denman St.

C22 Hampton Place/UBC Loop PERMANENT

Due to low ridership, this service will be discontinued. For alternative service, see routes C18 and C20.

C23 Main Street/Yaletown/Davie PERMANENT

Frequency for this service will be increased to meet ridership demand while reducing overcrowding, pass ups and wait times. Some trips will operate between Davie and Yaletown, while other trips will continue the extended routing to Main Street Station.

C28 Coquitlam Station/Port Moody Station PERMANENT

This service will change to a community shuttle vehicle in the weekday AM and PM peak periods. This is possible with the introduction of the new 178 which will reduce crowding on the C28 during these times.

C29 Parkway Boulevard/Coquitlam Station PERMANENT

This service will be rerouted via Johnson St. to improve service reliability by reducing wait times. For service travelling along Pinetree Way to and from Coquitlam Centre and Guildford Way, see routes 188 and C28.

C30 Lafarge Park/Coquitlam Station PERMANENT

This service will be rerouted via Westwood St. between Glen Dr. and Lincoln Ave. to improve service efficiency and reduce delays. An additional five stops along Westwood St. will be added to extend a portion of the route. Stops along Pinetree Way are serviced by routes 188 and C28.

C38 Port Coquitlam Station/Prairie/River Springs/Coquitlam Station PERMANENT

This service will be rerouted via Dewdney Trunk Rd. between Westwood and Lougheed Hwy. to improve service efficiency and reduce delays. Service will no longer route around Coquitlam Centre via Westwood St. To access Coquitlam Station, see routes 97, C27 and C28. Alternative service along Johnson St. to Coquitlam Station, see route C29. For an alternative route option along Westwood St., see routes C30 and C38.

C41 Meadowtown/Maple Meadows

Station/Pitt Meadows Centre PERMANENT

Service will operate every hour, Monday to Friday with service changing from a single direction route to a two-way circular service with 20 new stops travelling between Pitt Meadows Centre and Meadowtown Centre.

C48 Thornhill/Haney Place PERMANENT

Service will operate every two hours, Monday to Saturday. On weekday mornings, the C48 will connect with the West Coast Express train leaving Port Haney Station at 6:44 a.m., as well as to the 10:49 a.m. TrainBus. On weekday afternoons, the West Coast Express trains leaving downtown at 3:50 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. will connect with the C48 at Port Haney Station.

A number of changes to bay assignments will occur:

To accommodate the redevelopment of Brentwood Town Centre, the off-street Brentwood Station transit facility will be closed and a number of bays will be relocated:

Tapping in to Compass

By the end of January 2014, 80,000 customers will be tapping in and tapping out with their Compass Cards, including BC Bus Pass holders, CNIB users, and TransLink operating company employees. The roll out of Compass will keep tapping along in the coming months, with more customers making the switch group by group.

West Coast Express (WCE) customers will now be getting their cards in late spring. That's because we want to make some modifications to the online customer service channel that'll make it easier for WCE

customers to pay for their monthly passes and check their account. Until then, we'll continue to sell WCE 28-day and 7-day passes. We'll also keep selling FareSaver tickets into Spring/Summer 2014.



As the rollout continues, we'll keep checking

on the schedule and making tweaks as needed. And along the way, we'll keep you in the loop so you know when and how to get and use your Compass Card.
