The Burrard Otter II was loaded onto a heavylift carrier and began its journey here on the cargo ship on July 7.

You can expect to see the Burrard Otter II out and about over the next couple of months. After it goes through some additional sea trials and crew training, it will then be ready for regular SeaBus operations.

 Starting on Aug 4, the 44, 84, 258 and 480 routes relocated to Wesbrook Mall, just outside the bus loop, to accommodate construction of the new aquatic building.

Brentwood Mall Loop TEMPORARY
