

U-Pass fall/winter service reinstatements (SEASONAL)

19 Metrotown Station/Stanley Park (SEASONAL)

» The additional downtown shuttle service operating between West Pender and Cambie streets to Stanley Park is discontinued at the end of the summer tourist season, effective September 6, 2016.

150 White Pine Beach (SEASONAL)

» Service is discontinued effective September 6, 2016, and will return next summer.

210 Upper Lynn Valley/Vancouver (SEASONAL)

» A.M. trips leaving Burrard Station at 6:20, 6:50, 7:05, 7:17, 7:29, 7:41, 7:53, 8:05, 8:20, 8:35 and 8:50 a.m. return.

257 Horseshoe Bay/Vancouver Express (SEASONAL)

» Extra service is discontinued effective September 6, 2016, and will return next summer.

258 UBC/West Vancouver (SEASONAL)

» Weekday service to UBC returns.

236 Grouse Mountain/Pemberton Heights/Lonsdale Quay (SEASONAL)

» Regular service returns during midday hours Monday-Friday to coincide with end of tourist season.

620 Tsawwassen Ferry/Bridgeport Station (SEASONAL)

» Service returns to approximately one bus per hour to coincide with the fall ferry schedule, effective September 6, 2016. BC Ferries schedules: bcferries.com/schedules.

SeaBus (SEASONAL)

» Sunday/holiday service runs every 30 minutes, effective September 6, 2016.

C19 Alma/Spanish Banks (SEASONAL)

» Seasonal weekend service is discontinued until next summer, effective September 6, 2016.

C23 Main Street Station/Yaletown/Davie (SEASONAL)

» Weekday, midday service returns to normal service levels, to coincide with the end of tourist season.

C26 Buntzen Lake Special/Coquitlam Station Special (SEASONAL)

» Service between Buntzen Lake and Coquitlam Station is discontinued until next summer, effective September 6, 2016.

C52 Seaside/White Rock Centre (SEASONAL)

» Some weekday and weekend buses have been removed to coincide with demand. Visit translink.ca/servicechanges for the changes.

227 Lynn Valley Centre/Phibbs Exchange (SEASONAL)

» Seasonal shuttle service between Lynn Valley Centre and Lynn Canyon Park is discontinued effective September 6, 2016, and will return next summer. The regular route continues as scheduled.

Pattullo Bridge Rehabilitation

In May 2016, additional bus service was added to certain routes to mitigate congestion and improve on-time performance and reliability as part of the Pattullo Bridge Rehabilitation Project. With the construction ending in September 2016, bus service will return to normal service levels during AM and PM peaks on the following routes:

- » 104 22nd St. Station / Annacis Island
- » 340 22nd St. Station/Scottsdale
- » 388 22nd St. Station/Carvolth
- » 410 22nd St. Station/Railway

Loops and Exchanges

There are several bus bay changes at Guilford, Langley Centre and Newton exchanges. Please see *translink.ca/servicechanges* for assignments.

Permanent

005 Robson/Downtown (PERMANENT)

- » To accommodate the City of Vancouver's permanent closure of 800 Robson at Robson Square to vehicle traffic:
- 5 Downtown eastbound buses will continue to operate from Davie at Denman to Richards at Hastings, via Davie, Denman, Robson, Burrard, Pender, Homer, Hastings and Richards.
- 5 Robson westbound buses will continue to operate from Richards at Hastings to Davie at Denman, via Richards, Pender, Burrard, Robson, Denman and Davie.

49 Metrotown/UBC (PERMANENT)

» On weekends and holidays, all trips will be extended to UBC (previously ended at Dunbar loop) every 12 minutes and serviced by larger articulated buses.

320 Langley/Fleetwood/Surrey Central Station (PERMANENT)

- » The 320 now travels along 60th Avenue between 168th and 176th streets to serve customers who previously travelled on the 341.
- » Customers travelling on 64th Avenue will take the 364 or the 395.
- » For full details, visit translink.ca/servicechanges.

341/342 Langley Centre (Panorama Village) (PERMANENT)

- » The 341 is now split into two routes at Newton Exchange, providing new service along Highway 10 to Langley Centre; customers travelling through Newton Exchange will now transfer to the 342.
- » Customers travelling from Guildford to Langley Centre will transfer at Newton Exchange.

394 King George Boulevard (PERMANENT)

- » The 394 now has an easier to understand route with fewer stops between King George Station and White Rock Centre.
- » Visit *translink.ca/servicechanges* for details on new stop locations.

501/502/531/590/C63 - Brookswood/Langley Centre (PERMANENT)

- » The 501 and 590 have merged into a single route between Surrey Central and Langley Centre.
- There are limited stops between Surrey Central and Guildford.
- Customers who take the AM 590 trips to Surrey Central or the PM 590 trips to Langley will take the 501.
- » The 502 Surrey Central Station/Langley Centre now ends at Langley Centre and service to Brookswood will be discontinued.
- Brookswood residents can take the 531, in addition to the C63 service to Langley Centre to travel to and from Langley Centre.
- We'll temporarily maintain early morning 590 trips from Brookswood to Langley Centre with additional routing changes coming in December.
- » The 531 Willowbrook/White Rock Centre will better serve Langley Centre via 64th and 56th Avenues.
- Two 531 northbound trips from 40th Ave and 208th Street at 5:05 a.m. and

5:35 a.m. will serve Brookswood customers who previously took the 502.

595 Maple Meadows Station/Langley Centre (PERMANENT)

- » The 595 will now travel along 208th Street, creating direct access to transit.
- » The 501 merges with the 590 and will continue to accommodate customers who travel along 200 Street.

601 South Delta/Bridgeport Station (PERMANENT)

- » We're providing additional service from Boundary Bay during the A.M. peak.
- » The 8:11 a.m. northbound trip now starts at 1st Avenue/67 Street in Boundary Bay.

601/609 Tsawwassen Malls (PERMANENT) - NEW service

» The 601 will now route to Tsawwassen via 52nd Street to connect directly to the two new Tsawwassen malls; the 609 will reroute through the new Tsawwassen Mills development.

620 Tsawwassen Ferry/Bridgeport Station Express (PERMANENT)

- » There are now fewer stops between Bridgeport Station and Tsawwassen Ferry Terminal for faster service. For more details, visit translink.ca/servicechanges.
- » Seasonal changes in effect September 6: All additional seasonal trips to the ferry terminal will end, except trips on Fridays and Sundays (until October 10, 2016) to coincide with reduced customer demand.

C9 New Westminster Station/Lougheed Station (PERMANENT)

- » Introducing a new bus-only left turn signal on Cumberland Street.
- » Service on Columbia Street between Richmond Street and Cumberland Street will be discontinued.
- » The C9 will now travel through the Fraserview neighbourhood via Richmond and Cumberland streets.
