1958 The August 15, 1958 issue of The Buzzer announced that it's time for the PNE Fair again!

This year, the popular giant fair of the Pacific Coast will be bigger than ever, and will last two days longer-from Aug. 18 to Sept. 11—with all kinds of new attractions to be investigated by you and your family. To help cut down travelling time and maybe ease that parking problem, B.C. *Electric will operate increased transit services on all lines* leading to Exhibition Park during the two-week period. Theme this Centennial year forecasts our future - the age of space travel. Highlight and greatest single attraction ever undertaken by the PNE will be the fabulous Space Science Show. Already a gigantic rocket, equal in height to a sevenstorey building, dominates the skyline over the PNE grounds.
