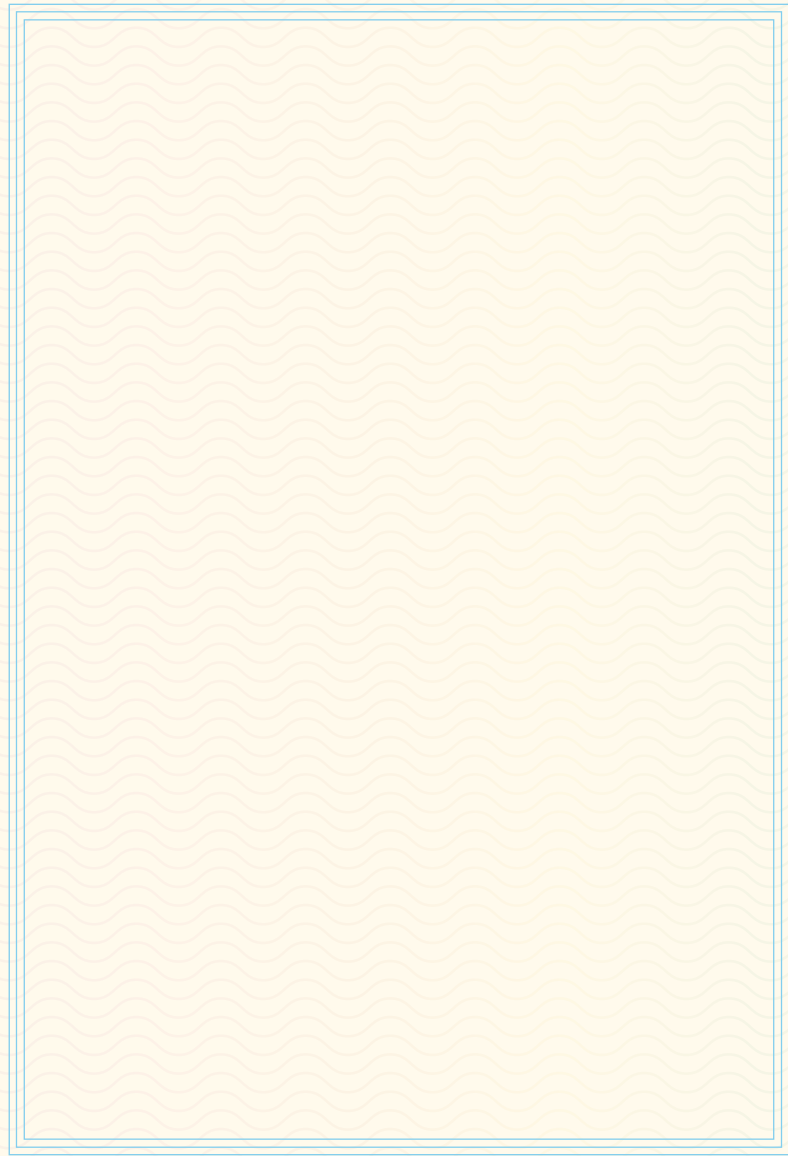

LOCAL HIGHLIGHTS

STREETCAR & FLIGHTS	Area
	North Vancouver
<p>Adventure through history, hops, and happiness in North Vancouver! Start with a scenic SeaBus ride to Lonsdale Quay, then explore a local transit history exhibit, complete with a vintage streetcar, at MONOVA: Museum of North Vancouver. Transit riders get 20% off admission.* Wrap up the day with more transit memorabilia and a craft beer at Streetcar Brewing—transit riders enjoy 25% off a tasting flight.*</p>

HERITAGE & LAKESIDE ESCAPE	Area
	Burnaby
<p>Experience Burnaby's yesteryear. Take the 144 Bus to Burnaby Village Museum and learn about the diverse communities of Burnaby's past—transit riders get 10% off at the gift shop.* Enjoy a lakeside lunch at the historic Hart House Restaurant and a 10% discount* for transit riders. Afterward, head to Deer Lake Park to rent a kayak, canoe, or pedal boat, or simply relax by the serene waters. Then hop on the 110 Bus to Dageraad Brewing where transit riders get 20% off select items.* Finish with a stroll to Burnaby Lake to watch the birds and take in a sunset.</p>

A MARITIMER'S WEST COAST MOMENT	Area

<p>Maritimers, you know beautiful coastlines and charming communities, but have you explored Vancouver's? Start by hopping on transit to Broadway & Main Street, and boom—you're in Mount Pleasant, one of the city's coolest pockets. Think indie boutiques, colourful murals, cozy cafés, and craft breweries. Take your time exploring, snacking, and shopping your way through this vibrant spot. When you're ready for a change, catch the 84 Bus west toward Kitsilano Beach. Grab takeout from one of the many spots on Yew Street, then head to the beach for a picnic, and swap your East Coast sunrise for a West Coast sunset.</p>

FROM MANITOBA TO MINI FERRIES	Area
	Vancouver
<p>Hi, Manitoba! If you're up for adding a little salty air and West Coast quirk to your summer, you've come to the right city. Start your tour on the 50 Bus to Granville Island—the perfect place to get breakfast and browse. Next, hop on a mini ferry across False Creek to the Aquatic Centre and stroll the Seawall 'til you spot Dennis Oppenheim's art installation, Engagement. Then make your way up Nicola Street through Vancouver's West End and you'll reach the Roedde House Museum—a beautifully restored historic home. Cap it all off with a bite and a shop along Davie or Robson Street and, if you still want more, head to Stanley Park and take it easy among the trees.</p>

FROM PEARSON TO PACIFIC	Area
	Vancouver
<p>You're fresh off a 5-hour flight from Toronto, so why not ground yourself with a calming afternoon tea at the Fairmont YVR? Book ahead and enjoy a 2-for-1 afternoon tea deal for transit riders.* Next, hop on the Canada Line to King Edward Station for next-level views and a tropical escape at Queen Elizabeth Park and the Bloedel Conservatory. Transit riders get 15% off admission.* Then ride the Canada Line to Waterfront Station, just steps from FlyOver Canada—a flight-seeing experience similar to yours, but shorter, smoother, and way more scenic! Plus, transit riders get 20% off admission.* Now that you've travelled by plane, SkyTrain, and flight simulator, cap it off with a SeaBus ride to the North Shore and swing by Copperpenny Distilling Co. (makers of Canada's first oyster shell gin) to enjoy a special deal for transit riders.*</p>

CRUISE SHIP TO QUEEN ELIZABETH PARK	Area
	Vancouver
<p>Cruise through Vancouver to one of the city's best views at Queen Elizabeth Park. Start with a quick walk from Canada Place to Waterfront Station and hop on the Canada Line. Ride to King Edward Station, walk 10 minutes and you're ready to soak in the skyline. Then wander into a tropical paradise at the Bloedel Conservatory—where city meets jungle and where transit riders get a deal.*</p>

LATTES TO LANDSCAPES	Area
	Maple Ridge
<p>Discover natural beauty, outdoor adventure, and unique local businesses in Maple Ridge. Board the R3 Bus to Bean Around Books, grab a pastry, and enjoy 20% off a beverage* as a transit rider. Next, pop into The ACT Arts Centre Gallery to see a current exhibit on your way to the bus loop. Take the 741 Bus to the Malcolm Knapp Research Forest and find a well-maintained trail for any hiking level.</p>

FROM FORT TO FLOWERS	Area
	Langley
<p>For a day of exploration, ride transit to the photogenic, tree-lined community of Fort Langley. The 562 Bus takes you downtown to unique local shops, antique stores, cafes, and restaurants, including Omni Kitchen + Bar, where transit riders get a deal.* After, enjoy a stroll along the Fraser River on the Fort-to-Fort Trail, or discover several nearby heritage museums. Take home a memento of your beautiful day from Floralista, a local floral shop where transit riders get 15% off select plants.*</p>

	Port Moody
<p>A colourful day in Port Moody is easily accessible by SkyTrain! Hop between breweries just steps from Moody Station along Brewers Row, including Moody Ales & Co, where transit riders get 10% off beer flights.* Then grab a bite to eat from the many shops and food trucks along the row. Finish with an ice cream and a stroll along the scenic Shoreline Trail at Rocky Point Park.</p>

STROLL, SIZZLE, SPLASH IN SURREY	Area
	Surrey
<p>Hot day? Cool off in Surrey with the kids! Catch the R1 Bus to Green Timbers Urban Forest Park for a shady stroll under the tree canopy. Walk the trails to the north side of the park where transit riders enjoy an exclusive deal at Zugba Flame Grilled Chicken.* After lunch, the kids can splash the day away at the Hawthorne Rotary Spray Park, and when you've all cooled off, the R1 will take you right back to Surrey Central Station and on to your next family adventure!</p>

PICNIC, PADDLE, REPEAT	Area
	White Rock
<p>Make it dinner with a view in scenic White Rock! Take the 321 or 351 Bus to Grounds & Greens Cafe to grab a coffee and some delicious food. Tell them you're a transit rider and get a free cookie with the purchase of a bowl.* Then hop on the 361 or 362 Bus and head to White Rock Beach for a seaside picnic.</p>

EAST VAN SIGN-SEEING	Area
	Vancouver
<p>Were you even in Vancouver if you don't have a photo of these two iconic East Vancouver signs? Get your proof by hopping on the 3, 8, 9, 19, or 99 B-Line Bus to Main & Broadway Street. From there, stroll over to the legendary "Dude Chilling Park" sign at 8th and Brunswick Street. Strike your best laid-back pose (bonus points if you match the statue). Next, head back to Broadway and catch the 9 or 99 B-Line Bus east to Clark Drive. Walk toward the mountains and you'll spot the camera-ready East Van Cross by Ken Lum. Continue on and you'll arrive at Strange Fellows Brewing, where transit riders get 20% off food and non-alcoholic drinks.* Time to chill (again). When you're ready to head back, VCC-Clark SkyTrain Station is just around the corner.</p>

FROM PRAIRIES TO PACIFIC TO PEAKS	Area
	Vancouver
<p>Visiting from the prairies? Experience a classic Vancouver day with a trip from the shores of the Pacific to the top of Grouse Mountain. Start by hopping on transit to English Bay to check out the A-maze-ing Laughter statues. Then wander along the Stanley Park Seawall to Second Beach and dip your toes in the Pacific. From there, walk past Lost Lagoon and make your way back to Waterfront Station, then hop on the SeaBus to Lonsdale Quay. Board the 236 Bus, which brings you to the base of the Skyride gondola on Grouse Mountain, where transit riders receive \$10 off admission.* Stay for a sunset dinner and jaw-dropping views and you've nailed it.</p>

VISITORS FROM THE NORTH, WELCOME TO THE DRIVE

Hey, Northerners! You know all about tight-knit communities, so you should feel right at home on Commercial Drive. Start your adventure with a bus ride down Hastings Street to Container Brewing, where you'll find award-winning beers and a deal for transit riders.* Then, swing by the Slice of Life Gallery—a funky spot full of local art—that offers riders 25% off their unique club programs, like pinball nights! From there, head south along “The Drive” (as locals call it) and explore the cozy cafés, indie bookstores, and laid-back charm on every corner. When you're ready to wrap up, hop on the 20 Bus and cruise to Commercial–Broadway SkyTrain Station then on to your next adventure!

CRUISE SHIP TO VAN DUSEN BOTANICAL GARDEN

Via transit, it's a breeze from the dock to VanDusen. Leave the terminal and walk to Granville and Pender Street, then hop on the 17 Bus, which drops you right in front of the garden—where transit riders receive 15% off general admission.* Think seasonal blooms, chirping birds, and even a full-on hedge maze (yes, really). Get lost in nature without leaving the city! When you're done, just catch the 17 Bus back.

Let the SkyTrain be your guide to vibrant public art along the Expo Line! Start with Adeyemi Adegbesan's striking Carry It Well banner at the Dunsmuir entrance to Granville Station. Then head to Stadium–Chinatown Station and look across the tracks for Natoya Ellis's powerful eight-piece series. Carry on to Main Street–Science World Station for Nya Lewis's bold outdoor installation, bike locker artwork, and The Watch Seller bronze statue. Continue to Nanaimo Station and three large-scale works by Heather Kai Smith. Finish at Joyce–Collingwood Station to enjoy two unique pieces by Renée Van Halm.

Where to get stamped: Waterfront Customer Service Centre, Commercial–Broadway SkyTrain Assistance Counter, or snap a photo of one SkyTrain art installation for your passport submission.

ALEXANDRA EATS

Area

Richmond

Hop off the Canada Line at Aberdeen or Lansdowne Station and discover Richmond's famed “Food Street” along Alexandra Road. Put Daan Go Cake Lab on your must-try list for sweet treats and an even sweeter deal for transit riders.* But save room for a delicious seafood dinner at Little Karp Seafood & Bar, where transit riders receive a free welcome drink.*

Take the SkyTrain to New Westminster Station, then climb the rainbow steps over the railroad tracks to the Fraser River Discovery Centre—where transit riders get a deal! Then stroll to Pier Park and enjoy contemporary Mexican cuisine at el Santo, and a special treat for transit riders.* After dinner, catch the SkyTrain to Sapperton Station and enjoy a 2-hour visit for the price of one as a transit rider at Capital City Arcade.*</p>

A DAY AT VANIER PARK	Area
	Vancouver
<p>Take the bus to Kitsilano and you’ll be within walking distance to three museums and a scenic waterfront view of the Vancouver skyline! The Museum of Vancouver, the H.R. MacMillan Space Centre, and the Vancouver Maritime Museum have exhibits folks of all ages will enjoy, and transit riders get a deal at all three locations.*</p>
