MANAGEMENT REPORT
FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2009**

The Financial Statements contained in this Statement of Financial Information under the Financial Information Act have been prepared by management in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, and the integrity and objectivity of these statements are management's responsibility. Management is also responsible for all the statements and schedules, and for ensuring that this information is consistent with the information contained in the financial statements.

Management is responsible for implementing and maintaining a system of internal controls to provide reasonable assurance that assets are safeguarded, transactions are properly authorized and recorded. The system includes written policies and procedures, an organizational structure that segregates duties and a comprehensive program of periodic audits by the internal auditors, who independently review and evaluate these controls. We continually monitor these internal accounting controls, modifying and improving them as business conditions and operations change. We recognize the inherent limitations in all control systems and believe our systems provide an appropriate balance between costs and benefits while providing reasonable assurance that those errors or irregularities that would be material to the financial statements are prevented or detected in the normal course of business.

The Board of Directors is responsible for ensuring that management fulfills its responsibilities for financial reporting and internal control and exercises this responsibility through the Audit Committee of the Board. The Audit Committee meets monthly with management and the internal auditor to discuss accounting policies, adequacy of internal controls, quality of financial reporting, internal and external audit work.

The external auditors, KPMG, conduct an independent examination, in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, and express their opinion on the financial statements. Their examination does not relate to the other schedules and statements required by the Act. Their examination includes a review and evaluation of the corporation's system of internal control and appropriate tests and procedures to provide reasonable assurance that the financial statements are presented fairly. The external auditors have full and free access to the Audit Committee of the Board.


